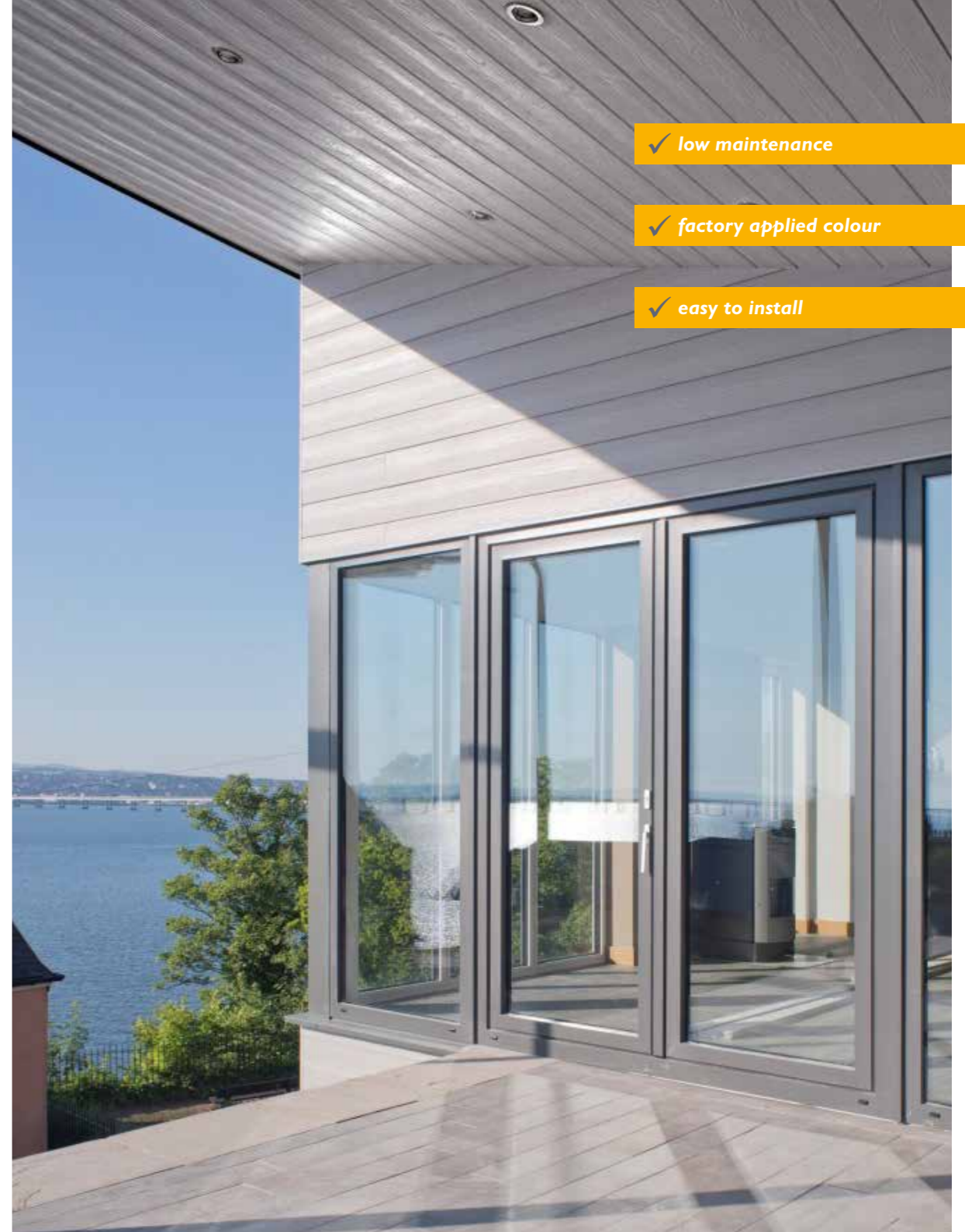

The simple combination of wood cellulose, sand, synthetic fibres, water and cement make fibre cement one of the most environmentally friendly and comprehensive building products available.

The material's multi-layered fibre structure supports the cement and other elements, which gives it impressive strength, and means that it can be far thinner than concrete.

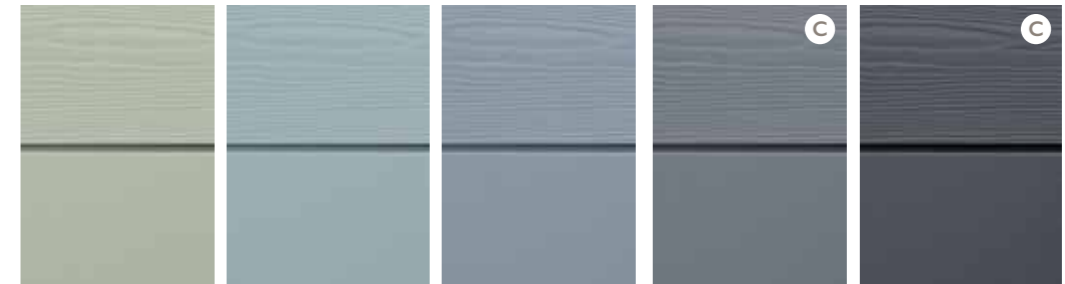

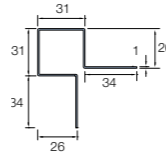
ALUMINIUM PROFILES

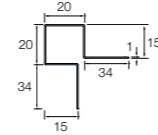
Profile (sizes in mm)

This universal trim can be used to provide protection on external corners and for stop profile applications.

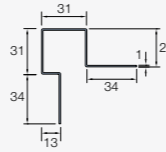


Cedral Click



External corner/window reveal (asymmetric)

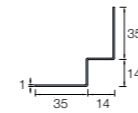
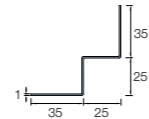
Can be used as an external corner or where detailing on a window reveal.



Not required

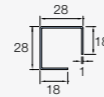
Internal corner

To finish the corner where Cedral meets on an internal corner forming a seal between the trim and the corner.



External corner junction

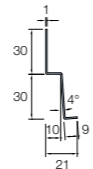
Used as a corner joining piece. Only available in black. 300mm length.

Used to start a cladding run with a lip to cover the first batten.



Profile (sizes in mm)

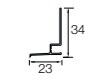
Vertical start profile

Used to start a vertical cladding run.

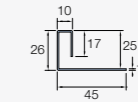

End profile

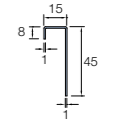
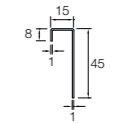
Hides any sharp corners and protects the Cedral edges from wear and tear.

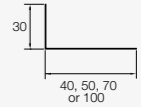
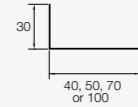
Connection profile

Perforated closure

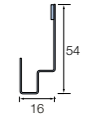
Used to protect against pest infestation and debris. Galvanised finish 2.5m length.



Window lintel profile

Used to finish above the window and to support next course of Cedral Click.
